Dear friend and neighbor,

Effective September 1st large item trash collection services will change to an appointment only based system. In order to have bulky trash items picked up you must call 311 or 513-1313 at least 48 hours in advance to schedule an appointment. Collections will not be made without an appointment. Bags and boxes will not be accepted. Items must meet certain guidelines. Go to www.kcmo.org/trash for complete information.

In Maple Park appointments will be accepted for the third trash day of the month only. Place regular or bulky items at the curb by 7:00 am on collection day, or after 3:00 pm the day before. Having bulky or regular trash at the curb at any other time is a violation of city codes. A ticket may be issued to violators.

We need everyone's help to keep the Maple Park Neighborhood a wonderful place to live. Let's work together to insure that Maple Park continues to be a good, clean, safe place in which to make our homes.
